


Super Bowl LIII: Time-lapse shows Mercedes-Benz Stadium being built

CLEVELAND, Ohio – Mercedes-Benz Stadium in Atlanta is the site of Super Bowl LIII between the New England Patriots and Los Angeles Rams.

The HOK-designed stadium took three years to build and opened in 2017. (Progressive Field was designed by HOK Sport, a former division of the company.)

The 90-second time-lapse covers 39 months of work. EarthCam construction cameras were onsite from June 2014 to September 2017.
